Female Challenge

6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17-29, 30-39, 40 & Over

Mighty 11 – Special Class

Class available to male & female riders 11 years on 20 October 2012.

This is an 'Age on the day' class.

Riders must ride age or test team in addition to this class

Mighty 11 Test Team riders MUST enter this class.

Cruiser Classes:

Mixed 8-10, 11-12.

Male 13-14, 15-16, 17-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50 & over

Female 13-16, 17-29, 30-39, 40 & over

In all events - 5 riders constitute a class.

5 - 8 riders:

Points over 4 motos.

9 - 24 riders

3 motos, with top 8 riders competing in a 3 heat final.

3 motos, with top 16 competing in a deadman semi final,

Top 8 riders to a 3 heat final.

No runoffs will be held within the Superclass.

BMX NZ computer moto mixing & lane draws

Quarter & Semi Finals – snake seeding method

Olympic Lane Draw:

Quarters, Semis and Finals Only. Computer seeding order of lane choice based on count back to moto points.

Championship 20” Classes:

Racing will be in ‘Block’ format with each round occurring at approximately 20-30 minute intervals.

Number Plates:

Number plates will be issued to riders by the Club Team Manager and must be used within this event, including all official practice sessions.

A rider holding a 1 – 8 ranking from the following meetings; Worlds 2012, BMX NZ National Championships 2012, Oceania Championships 2012, North Island Titles 2011 or South Island Titles 2012 and wish to use this number at the meeting, the ranking must be clearly marked on the entry form. All riders not entering with these rankings, will be issued with randomly selected numbers.

Mighty 11 and Senior Test Teams (New Zealand & Australia)

NOTE: All Test Team riders are required to enter their Age Class or the Mighty 11 Class as applicable, in addition to the Test Team classes.

Mighty 11 Class:

Trophies to 3rd place and Presentation Plates to 8th place.

Championship Classes:

Trophies to 3rd place, with the title “North Island Champion”

Superclass:

No trophies or Presentation Plates will be issued.

Purse will be divided using the BMX NZ proportions with the purse split between the classes based on entry numbers.

Presentation of the Prize money will be made at the Prize giving.

Class numbers:

Determined from the time that entries close for Trophy purposes.
